MoDOT Updates – Shannon Kusilek (Adam Watson was unable to attend so Shannon reported on items on his behalf, in addition to his own items)

❖ **BRO Rescission**

Shannon reported that Congress decided to repeal the rescission. The BRO program will move forward. Shannon isn't sure how the current FAST Act will be funded.

❖ **Recently Awarded Projects**

Shannon shared a list of recently awarded projects from September through November 2019:

 - Nodaway Rte. 46 from Ravenwood to Grant City – resurfacing – Herzog, \$3,975,442

- ❖ Traffic Engineering Assistance Program (TEAP)

Shannon announced that Cameron received a TEAP grant to study the intersection of McElwain Drive and US 36.

❖ I-229 Double Decker Bridge Study Update

Shannon had a presentation showing the six reasonable alternatives for how to proceed with the double decker bridge. The six reasonable alternatives are: Four Build Alternatives, Rehabilitate the Existing Structure, or Take no action, also referred to as No-Build (required by law as a baseline for comparison).

Roadway Safety Assessment (RSA) – Amy Dowis & Shannon Kusilek

Amy reported that the planners and MoDOT staff had met recently to discuss whether or not its beneficial to continue conducting Roadway Safety Assessments on an annual basis. The sites we have assessed recently haven't had enough crashes to merit assessments. After some discussion, the TAC members decided to take Amy's recommendation that we conduct annual assessments, unless a situation arises that warrants an assessment, then we would pull an RSA team together. TAC members were asked to bring any roadway safety concerns to TAC meetings for discussion.

Transportation Prioritization – Amy Dowis

TAC members conducted their annual STIP and Maintenance prioritization processes at the meeting. Information regarding the STIP projects had been emailed to the TAC members prior to the meeting so they could be familiarizing themselves with the list of projects to rank/score. We went through the projects as a group allowing county representatives time to talk about their projects and answer any questions about them, and we showed a PowerPoint presentation with photos and maps of all projects before prioritization began.
