# Northwest Missouri Transportation Advisory Committee Quarterly Meeting Minutes, February 18, 2020

## Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Gary Carlson at 6:02 p.m. at the Northwest Missouri Regional Council of Governments.

### *Replacing TAC Members*

Atchison County still has a vacancy on TAC.

## New Business

### *Northwest Missouri Transportation Planning Partners' Annual Meeting*

Amy announced that this year's event is scheduled for Friday, June 5, and will be held in Albany at a site to be determined. Amy asked the TAC members if there were any items they would like to have covered as topics for the meeting. New technology for snow removal and filling potholes were brought up as possible topics.

### *Review TAC By-Laws*

Amy presented the current TAC By-Laws, which were written many years ago. The TAC members went through these as a group and held a lot of discussion. Shannon made a couple of suggestions for changes. It was the consensus of the TAC members to change the wording on how attendance is handled so that if someone misses consecutive meetings it goes back to their county commission to make a decision as to whether or not the individual should be removed from TAC. Amy will work on the revisions and hopes to have them ready to present at the May TAC meeting.

### *Roadway Safety Review (At each meeting, TAC members will be asked to share concerns about safety issues on area roadways to pass on to MoDOT)*

We went around the room and gave each TAC member an opportunity to share any roadway safety concerns they have for their area. Shannon and David will take these back to the MoDOT maintenance staff for review.

### *Review Ranked STIP Priorities*

Amy presented a spreadsheet of the final STIP rankings from the December TAC meeting. These will go to the Regional Council Board for final approval before being submitted to MoDOT. The lists are attached.

### *MoDOT Update*

Shannon Kusilek gave a MoDOT update to include the following:

- 1) TAP Applications. Should have a call for projects in August.
- 2) Flood Repair Projects. MoDOT has elected to move some projects back due to flooding potential. Atchison/Holt Routes D, U, Z, E and W were moved back to May and Holt 111 from Corning to US 159 was moved back to June.
- 3) Regional Prioritization. This will become a yearly process. Will prioritize projects from the region. Tier 1 list - \$50 million statewide to program in first couple years of STIP. Tier 2 – unfunded needs.
- 4) Recently Awarded Projects. Shannon said the following were awarded in January:  
Atchison Co US 136 from I29 to Route O, scrub seal, Vance Brothers, \$348,800.  
Atchison/Nodaway Co. US 136 from Little Tarkio Creek to Route 71, scrub seal, Vance Brothers, \$359,600. MO 46 Bridges (Florida Creek, White Cloud Creek, Stream, Big Slough), Boon Construction, \$2.796 million.
- 5) Upcoming Project Bid Openings.
  - a. March 2020 – Atchison County Route B: Resurfacing due to hauling material for flood repair; and Holt County Route T: Fix slide and re-establish roadway.
  - b. May 2020 – Atchison/Holt Routes D, U, Z, E, W reclaim roadway surface.
  - c. June 2020 – Holt County 111: Repair roadway and shoulders from Corning to US 159 (flood): 4 projects. Nodaway County US 136: 102 River to Route J, resurface and shoulders. Atchison County US 136: Missouri River to I-29 permanent pavement resurfacing. Holt County US 159: Missouri River to Route P permanent pavement resurfacing.

David Earls gave a ModOT update to include the following:

- MoDOT is not currently programming BRO projects that cause a negative BRO balance. This is due to the uncertainty of the transportation bills.
- Any STP small urban funding that has not been obligated has been swept. There is no longer funding for bid award increases or change orders.
