Project Awards/Upcoming

- Atchison B (I-29 to 59) resurfacing – tentative start May 1
- Holt 111 (118 to 159) resurfacing – tentative start mid-March
- Holt 111 (W near Corning to Spur 111 near Craig) and Atchison/Holt 111 (E to W near Corning) resurfacing – tentative start mid-March.
- Atchison D (A to 136 near Phelps City), Atchison U (136 to E near Phelps City), Atchison E (U to 111 near Langdon), and Holt W (I-29 to 111 near Corning) resurfacing – tentative start mid-March

- Atchison V, Atchison Z (I-29 to end of state maintenance), and Atchison U (E to end of state maintenance) resurfacing – tentative start mid-March.
- Nodaway 136 (102 River to 46 near Ravenwood) resurfacing – tentative start end of March.
- Gentry 169 bridge rehab over the Middle Fork Grand (.6 miles East of YY) – tentative start May

**Recent Project Awards**

- November
  - Bridge redeck over Grand River on US 169 in Gentry Co. – Emery Sapp & Sons (\$1.4 million)
  - Bridge redeck over I-29 on Rte. B in Holt Co. – Lehman Construction (\$1.1 million)
  - Bridge scour repair over Missouri River on US 136 in Atchison Co. – Lehman Construction (\$1.9 million)
- December
  - Resurfacing on MO 46 from MO 113 to Icon Rd. – Herzog (\$937,000)
- February
  - Bridge paintings on 6 bridges on I-29 in Holt Co. – Omega Coatings (\$1.1 million)
  - Roadway repairs and resurfacing due to flood damage on Rte. BB/TT/A in Atchison Co. - Emery Sapp & Sons (\$1.9 million)

**Upcoming Bid openings:**

- February
  - I 29 bridge rehabilitation on bridge over Nishnabotna River in I-29

- May
  - FARM design-build project – 2 bridges in Atchison County may be selected.
    - Bridge over Little Tarkio Creek – MO 46
    - Bridge over Pike Creek Drainage Ditch – MO 111
  - Resurfacing due to windfarm damage in Nodaway and Atchison Co.
    - Nodaway Co. – Rte. V, TT & ZZ
    - Atchison Co. – Rte. C, M, AA

**Update on MoDOT funding**

- The Highway Commission approved new statewide funding levels and targets for the upcoming STIP at the February meeting
  - \$234.8 million from Covid Relief Act – Help to restore lost revenue from pandemic last spring/summer.
  - \$48 million from CARES Act redirected by the Governor to MoDOT.
  - Amendment 3 bonding – MoDOT to issue 2 short term bonding in 2024 and 2026 (\$500 million each time)
- Impacts on the Northwest District
  - Increases STIP funds for the 2022 STIP by \$27 million.
  - Additional \$4.1 million per year for 2022-2024 to help NW District to maintain Asset Management Plan
  - \$16 million in Focus on Bridges backfill funds became available – Previous identified projects will be programmed in 2022 STIP.
  - Additional \$12 million to cover the district share for the 2019 Flood Recovery projects from 2019-2022
  - Additional maintenance funds for low volume route resurfacings in 2022-2024
    - \$5.9 million in 2022
    - \$5.9 million in 2023
    - \$4.6 million in 2024

*Prioritization of Projects – Shannon Kusilek & Amy Dowis*

- Each year we reach out to our five County Commissions to get input on projects to prioritize for STIP, Maintenance, Multi-Modal and Safety (Safety was just added this year). There were not new projects to come from this exercise, so our goal this year was to recommend approximately \$15 million of projects to be elevated from the Tier 2 list to the Tier 1 list. After a lengthy discussion, a list was agreed upon. The chart below shows the projects that were chosen:

Worth	1	Replace Br. J0024 over Marlowe Branch (35)
Worth	2	Replace Br. X0142 over West Fork Grand River (36)
Nodaway	3	Replace Br. R0014 over Platte River (43)
Holt	4	Hwy 59 from Oregon to Mound City
Nodaway	5	Replace Br. P0981 over Platte River (34)
Atchison	6	Replace Br. J0222 over East Fork High Creek (39)
Nodaway	7	US Hwy. 71 from Iowa line to 148
